Outstanding fees payable to a George Mason University Club Sports team should be paid directly to the club. Please communicate directly with the Mason club officers in reference to any outstanding payments.


### **Important Policies**

- Users of Mason Recreation facilities are expected to comply with the policies and procedures for each specific activity area.
- Users of any recreational facility must comply with requests made by the Campus Recreation Staff.
- Disorderly conduct, inappropriate behavior, abuse of the facility, equipment or staff, and/or disregard for Campus Recreation rules may result in immediate dismissal from the facility.
- Alcohol is NOT permitted in/at any Mason Recreation facility.
- Incidences and injuries should be reported to a Mason Recreation staff member or Club Safety Officer immediately.
- Food and drink are not permitted in activity areas. Water is permitted in activity areas in a sealed, non-glass container.
- Pets and animals other than service animals are prohibited.
- Teams and spectators should ensure that all trash has been placed in the proper receptacles.
- Please follow posted parking regulations. Mason Recreation is not responsible parking fines.
   Please communicate with the Mason club officers in reference to any parking restrictions for your event.

## **Recreation Athletic Center (RAC)**




Visiting teams and spectators competing in the RAC or on RAC Field should park in the PV Lot or Lot K. Parking in these lots during a scheduled Club Sports competition is FREE and does not require a decal on Saturday and Sunday. Additional parking is available in the MASON POND PARKING DECK (#40) for a small fee.

Visiting teams and spectators should check-in at the front desk of the RAC when entering the facility.

## **West Campus Fields and Tennis Complex**




Visiting teams and spectators should park in the spots located along RAPIDAN RIVER ROAD or in the WEST CAMPUS PARKING LOT for events occurring on Saturday and Sunday. Parking along RAPIDAN RIVER ROAD and the West Campus lot is FREE and does not require a decal for Club Sports competitions occurring on Saturday and Sunday. Parking in the grass is not permitted.

Restroom facilities are available at the pavilion located between Field 4 and Field 5 along RAPIDAN RIVER ROAD.

## **Aquatics and Fitness Center (AFC)**


Visiting teams and spectators should park in LOT C for events taking place in the Aquatic & Fitness Center (#1). Parking is FREE for Club Sport competitions and does not require a decal for events occurring on Saturday and Sunday. Additional parking is available in the SHENANDOAH PARKING DECK (#42) for a small fee.

Visiting teams and spectators should check-in at the front desk of the AFC when entering the facility.

Folding chairs are not permitted in the Aquatic & Fitness Center.

## Field House, Mason Stadium, and Spuhler Field

Visiting teams and spectators should park in LOT O or P for events taking place at the Field House, Mason Stadium, or Spuhler Field. Parking in LOT O and P is FREE and does not require a decal on Saturday and Sunday.

## **ATHLETIC TRAINING**

Certified Athletic Trainers assist in the coverage of Mason Club Sports home competitions.

- Each Club Sport team has a team Safety Officers trained in CPR/AED/First Aid and the university emergency action plans for all on-campus facilities.
- An Athletic Trainer will be onsite for high-risk team sport competitions It is recommended that all visiting teams bring their own medical supplies for taping if necessary.
- Please touch base with the club safety officer and/or athletic trainer prior to the start of your event with any questions.
- All injuries during club sport activities must be reported to the host team and club officers.
- Please communicate with a Club Sport Safety Officer or athletic trainer to ensure all injuries have been properly documented.
- In the event of a medical emergency occurring in the absence of a club safety officer or athletic trainer, call 911. (see on-campus facility EAP's below)
- There are several hospitals or emergency facilities within 5 minutes of campus.

## **EMERGENCY ACTION PLANS**

#### **RAC**

Facility Address: 4350 Banister Creek Ct., Fairfax, VA 22030

**Emergency Personnel:** Manager on Duty, safety officer(s), and/or athletic trainer on site for practice and competition

**Emergency Communication:** cell phone of athletic trainer/safety officer and/or radio of athletic trainer/MOD. A landline is also located at the front desk.

**Emergency Equipment:** Club Sports First Aid Kits or Front Desk Med Box

- AEDs are located in the front lobby and on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor outside the racquetball/squash courts.
- Additional emergency equipment accessible from EMS.

#### **Roles of Safety Officers/First Responders**

- 1. Immediate care of injured or ill student-athlete
- 2. Activation of EMS
  - a. Call 9-1-1: provide name, location of field, telephone number, number of individuals injured, condition of injured, first aid treatment, specific directions, other information requested.
- 3. Emergency equipment retrieval
- 4. Direction of EMS to scene
  - a. Designate individual to "flag down" EMS and direct to scene
  - b. Scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area.

**Venue Directions: 4350 Banister Creek Ct., Fairfax VA 22030:** Enter University off University Drive onto George Mason Blvd. Turn right onto Patriot Circle and left onto Campus Drive.

#### Position where personnel will meet emergency help:

• One person will be out front of RAC entrance to direct the ambulance.

Contact campus police in the event of a medical emergency or disruptive incident.

Emergency Equipment: Club Sports First Aid Kits or Outdoor Supervisors Med Kit

- AEDs are located inside RAC building and/or with the outdoor supervisor
- Additional emergency equipment accessible from EMS.

#### **Roles of Safety Officers/First Responders**

- 1. Immediate care of injured or ill student-athlete
- 2. Activation of EMS
  - a. Call 9-1-1: provide name, location of field, telephone number, number of individuals injured, condition of injured, first aid treatment, specific directions, other information requested.
- 3. Emergency equipment retrieval
- 4. Direction of EMS to scene
  - a. Designate individual to "flag down" EMS and direct to scene
  - b. Scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area.

**Venue Directions: 4350 Banister Creek Ct., Fairfax VA 22030:** Enter University off University Drive onto George Mason Blvd. Turn right onto Patriot Circle and left onto Campus Drive. RAC field will be immediately on the right next to the RAC building.

#### Position where personnel will meet emergency help:

One person will be on Campus Drive by the double gate entrance to direct the ambulance.

Contact campus police in the event of a medical emergency or disruptive incident.

  - a. Designate individual to "flag down" EMS and direct to scene
  - b. Scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area.

**Venue Directions: West Campus:** Enter University off Braddock Rd. onto Campus Dr. Turn Right onto West Campus Way. then at the stop sign turn right or left depending on what field you are going to.

#### Position where personnel will meet emergency help:

• One person will be either on West Campus Way or Rapidan River Rd. to direct the ambulance.

Contact campus police in the event of a medical emergency or disruptive incident.

**Emergency Communication:** cell phone of safety officer and/or radio of lifeguards/MOD. A landline is also located at the front desk and head guard office.

Emergency Equipment: Club Sports First Aid Kits or Front Desk/Lifeguards Med Kits

- AEDs are located at the front desk and the head guard office.
- Additional emergency equipment accessible from EMS.

#### **Roles of Safety Officers/First Responders**

- 1. Immediate care of injured or ill student-athlete
- 2. Activation of EMS
  - a. Call 9-1-1: provide name, location of field, telephone number, number of individuals injured, condition of injured, first aid treatment, specific directions, other information requested.
- 3. Emergency equipment retrieval
- 4. Direction of EMS to scene
  - a. Designate individual to "flag down" EMS and direct to scene
  - b. Scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area.
